APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1) Complete and submit this Application for Admission with a non-refundable \$10 application fee.
- 2) Provide an official high school transcript or official GED test results as well as official transcripts from any colleges you have attended.
- 3) Provide proof of immunization with two (2) doses of Measles, Mumps, and Rubella (MMR) vaccine. This applies to all students born after January 1, 1957.
- 4) Provide proof of two (2) doses of the Varicella (chicken pox) vaccine, administered on or after the first birthday. This applies to all students born after January 1, 1980.
- 5) Submit a completed Northeast State Hepatitis B Immunization Health History Form.
- 6) All documents required for admission must be submitted prior to first day of classes.

Northeast State Community College is one of 45 institutions in the Tennessee Board of Regents system, the sixth largest system of higher education in the nation. The Tennessee Board of Regents is the governing board for this system, which is comprised of six universities, 13 community colleges, and 26 area technology centers. The TBR system enrolls more than 80 percent of all Tennessee students attending public institutions of higher education.
