

TN eCAMPUS PROGRAM INFORMATION

TN eCampus online courses are another option for students to take a class at Northeast State. Classes are taught by instructors from Tennessee Board of Regents colleges and universities all across the state of Tennessee. Students never have to physically attend a class, but they do have to be prepared to take a proctored (in person) mid-term and/or final exam. Students do not have to be logged in to their TN eCampus class at any certain time or day of the week. Courses are available for students to work in 24/7. However, TN eCampus courses have assignment/test due dates just like in any other class. **The only contact that students have with their TN eCampus course instructors is through the TN eCampus class e-mail.**

Registration for these courses occurs by using the Northeast State MyNortheast system just like any other Northeast State class. TN eCampus courses are designated in "look up classes" by sections beginning with "R." **Please note:** Be careful when choosing a TN eCampus class section. Section **R50** is a **full-semester class**; Section **R01** is an accelerated **7-week class** beginning the first week of the semester, and ending mid-semester; Section **R25** is an accelerated **7-week class** beginning mid-semester and ending at the end of the semester.

The last day to register for TN eCampus classes is the day before classes begin.
ATTENTION: Students taking an online class section beginning with "R" (TN eCampus),
or those considering taking a TN eCampus class, **PLEASE READ ON!**

To make sure that the TN eCampus learning experience is an enjoyable one, here are a few instructions on "**What To Do Next**" after registering for a TN eCampus course.

1. Go to www.bkstr.com/tneampusstore/home and order textbooks as soon as possible in order to have textbooks before classes begin. **NOTE: THE NORTHEAST STATE BOOKSTORE DOES NOT HAVE TN eCampus TEXTBOOKS AVAILABLE IN STOCK FOR PURCHASE.**
2. Tuition and fees should be paid by the due date in order to avoid being purged/dropped from class(es). **A BILL WILL NOT BE SENT THROUGH THE MAIL.** Payments can be made at www.NortheastState.edu/accountsuite. Please note: TN eCampus on-line course fees are non-refundable after classes begin.
3. Tuition and fees for TN eCampus courses are somewhat higher than tuition and fees for Northeast State courses. Check current semester campus literature for the current tuition and fees rates.
4. Students may have to come to the Blountville campus for a proctored mid-term and final exam. If the course instructor states that exams must be proctored, an appointment can be scheduled at www.NortheastState.edu/testing with the Northeast State Testing Center.
5. To login to your TN eCampus course, go to www.tneampus.info (NOT Northeast State D2L), click the "Go to Class" link, click "TN eCampus students", and read the instructions for user name and password. **Note: The Northeast State D2L ID and password will not work for the TN eCampus log-in.**

Students will not be able to access their course until the first day of class (usually beginning at 4:00 p.m. Eastern time) as given in the TN eCampus semester calendar.

It is very important that students log in to (go to class) their TN eCampus class the FIRST DAY of class! PLEASE NOTE: In order to have **attendance** verified for students receiving **financial aid**, it is imperative that the student complete the *Student Participation Survey* (located on every course homepage) immediately upon logging in to **EACH** TN eCampus class.
