A Technical Certificate Program

PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

The Customer Service and Sales certificate will provide individuals the knowledge and skills associated with customer service, inside and outside sales and marketing, communication and promotion, and the use of computer technology for customer relationship management.

PROGRAM ARTICULATION

All courses in the Customer Service and Sales certificate program will articulate into the Associate of Applied Science degree program in Business - Concentration: Management. If applicable to the student, additional courses may be required to overcome deficiencies in mathematics to complete the A.A.S. degree.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

A student desiring to enroll in the technical certificate program in Customer Service and Sales must:

1. Submit the Northeast State Application for Admission to the Office of Admissions and Records.
2. Indicate Customer Service and Sales certificate as the desired major on the Northeast State application form.
3. See a faculty advisor from the Business program prior to registering for classes.

Sales and Distribution Business Associate:
